

Christmas Puzzle Wreath

1. Place 5-7 puzzle pieces in a wreath shape. You will need 10 to 14 peices per wreath.
Hint: use a cup to get them in a circle.
2. Glue the surface of the puzzle pieces. Make sure to place the glue so the first layer of pieces are offset from the second layer.
3. Let the glue dry.
4. Spray paint the front of the wreath.
5. Quickly dump a ton of glitter on the wreath. Tip: place the wreath in a contanior or on a piece of paper to collect the extra glitter.
6. Let the paint dry and then shake off the excess glitter which you can use for other wreaths.
7. Spray paint the back.
8. Use hot glue to fasten a string for hanging purposes.

Recommended:

- Use a glossy spray paint.
- Seal the sparkles with a clear finish.
- Add embellishments to liven up the wreath!
